U5 – U8 Miniros (Aldi Miniros Girls Kick Off)

- Girls Kick Off has been designed as the perfect pathway for girls to get into football - a program that allows them to share smiles with their friends and learn how to play one of the world's safest sports.
- The weekly sessions allow young girls to build confidence while learning the basic skills of the game without the added pressure of performing in games against other teams.
- Small sided soccer with an emphasis on fun and fitness whilst learning the rules of the game.
- Miniros is a training program where the emphasis is on learning grassroots soccer skills in a fun and supportive learning environment and then introducing competition soccer through round robin gala events.
- Games are played with 4 or 5 a side with no goalkeepers.
- Train once per week (Saturday morning). No preseason training.
- All players provided with a BEFC Uniform of Playing Top, Shorts & Socks.
- Parents need to provide soccer boots, shin guards & mouthguard (if using one).
- Members of the ALDI Miniros Girls Kick Off Program, will also receive an ALDI participation kit consisting of boot bag, size 3 ball, shin pads, sticker sheet + drink bottle

Parental Involvement

All U5 – U8 Miniros teams have a Volunteer Parent Coach who will be offered a full refund of registration fees.

If you are new to coaching kids sport and wish to volunteer, training, support and mentoring is available. Miniros coaching training certificates are available and free of charge to attend.

If no volunteers, we will seek a non-parental coach to step in, however a coaching levy may apply to fund the coaching costs.

Team Managers are a focus for communication both amongst the team member but also the Programme Manager and Club Administrator. Prime responsibility is for organising rosters of various team duties to be performed by all the parents in the team, not just the manager. For U5 – U8 teams this could simply be Gala Day attendance and organising team leaders plus oranges for after training.
