

Fee Summary for the 2018 Season

For the past few years, there have been no increases to our schedule of fees; however we have included extra services and uniforms as part of the packages.

Due to increases in running costs, the Club is unable to absorb these costs for the coming year however we do maintain to deliver an outstanding soccer program for all our members.

In part this is due to increasing costs such as facilities, uniforms and equipment to name a few, but also due to a lack of volunteers to help run the week-to-week events of the club such as BBQ, working bees, start/end of season set up/pack up, gala days etc.

If a decline in Volunteers continues, the Committee will seek to introduce a Volunteer Levy per family similar to that imposed at Kindergartens, Schools and some sporting organisations.

Registration Fee Discounts

FAMILY DISCOUNT

For two or more players in one family/household; the second and any other subsequent players will receive a \$25 fee reduction. (That fee can be deducted from the Registration Fee and is selected as an Add-On at time of payment). No other discounts apply.

TERTIARY STUDENT/APPRENTICE DISCOUNT

Tertiary students and apprentices will receive a \$70 fee reduction. (That fee will be deducted from the Registration Fee and is selected as an Add-On at time of payment). No other discounts apply.

HARDSHIP

In the first instance please write to the Club Administrator for assistance here.

Fee Refunds

- Prior to Team Announcement: If a player withdraws prior to team placement, a refund will be provided for the amount paid, less an administration fee of \$50 and training sessions attended.
- After Team Announcement: If a player withdraws after team placement, a refund will be provided for the amount paid, less FFA/FFV fees paid, the FFV deregistration fee, training session attended and an administration fee of \$50.
- After Start of Season: Requests will only be considered in exceptional circumstances. In the first instance please write to the Club Administrator for assistance here.

Credit Card Payment: Visa and MasterCard Only

All members, please be aware that the only payment method for the season will be through online credit card payment. As was the case in 2017, the MyFootballClub site will add to your playing fee, a merchant and site-fee of 1.8%.

Unfortunately we can no longer accept alternatives such as cash, cheques and direct deposits due to the administrative load and merchant fee costs generated by these payment methods.

Parent Commitment at BEFC

We are a community club with a heavy reliance on parent-support. Over the course of the season we will make reasonable requests to all player-parents to give time freely with activities such as the set-up of grounds, 'running the line', team-management and assisting with the club barbeque.

Registration Fee Reimbursements – Volunteer Positions

PLEASE NOTE:

Full fees are payable at the start of the season.

At the end of the season, once all equipment is returned and paperwork is submitted the fees are paid directly into nominated bank-accounts. Refunds are only available for 1 player per family.

Only 1 coaching refund is payable per team.

At BEFC we recognise that there are some roles and responsibilities undertaken by our player parents that are involved and in appreciation we offer a full rebate or partial rebate of fees dependent on the position. Positions that attract a fee rebate are as follows:
