U9 – U11 Miniroos (Home & Away Competition)

- The objective of our program is to provide boys and girls with a quality soccer experience that is fun and inclusive in a supportive environment.
- Team spirit and good sportsmanship are always emphasised.
- Games are played with 7 a side (U9) and 9 a side (U10 – U11)
- Young Referees are provided for U10 & U11 Teams. U9 Teams use a Parent Referee.
- Competition Players will have team training once per week plus a home and away competition game on a Saturday morning (Boys) or Sunday morning (Girls).
- Competition games at Miniroos level have no scores or ladders.
- All U9 – U11 Players have an additional optional night technical training per week with Qualified Specialist Coaches. Dates to be advised.
- All players provided with a BEFC Uniform of Playing Top, Shorts & Socks. Parents need to provide soccer boots, shin guards & mouthguard (if using one).

Team Placement

Returning players are initially placed in the same teams as the year prior. You would expect movement of players between teams to accommodate new players and for player skill development. Final team placement will be confirmed prior to the end of pre-season in March.

KANGAS SELECTION

Kangas teams are comprised of players with the highest skill level in their age group.

Selection for entry into a Kangas team is by a rolling and objective assessment of skill level during pre-season, conducted by the Head Coach and specialist grading coaches. The decision for entry into Kangas teams will rest with the Head Coach.

Previous placement in a Kangas team does not guarantee a spot in a Kangas team for the following season.

Parental Involvement

All U9 – U11 Miniroo teams have a Volunteer Parent Coach who will be offered a full refund of registration fees. If no volunteers, we will seek a non-parental coach to step in, however a coaching levy will apply to fund the coaching costs. Competition Teams will need a parent volunteer Team Manager. See [your Program Manager or Age Group Coordinator](#) for further information. All U9 Teams also require a Parent Referee for Home Games. As a Community Club we heavily rely on Volunteers at the Club. There are many ways in which you can contribute so please let us know if you have any special skills or interests that can help enrich our club.
