U5 - U8 Mini Eagles (Skills Program)

- Skills based small-sided football with an emphasis on fun and fitness whilst learning the rules of the game.
- Mini Eagles is a training program where the emphasis is on learning grassroots football skills in a fun and supportive learning environment and then introducing competition football through round robin gala events.
- Any games are played with 4 or 5 a side with no goalkeepers.
- Program runs throughout school terms 1, 2 and 3.
- For those wanting to train twice a week, you can book in for our Specialist Training Program, 12 sessions on Mondays from 6 – 7pm (\$200).
- Players registered for the Full Year or terms 2 and 3 will be provided with a full BEFC playing kit. Parents need to provide boots, shin guards and mouthguard (if using one). Boots from 1st April.

U8 Girls or Boys (Mini Eagles or MiniRoos Competition)

- Players can either participate in the Skills Program or may choose to play competition matches against other clubs in an organised league. Parents decide this at the time of registration and teams are dependent on demand for places.
- Skills Players will train once per week (see term by term dates) and will follow the same program as our U5 - U7 Mini Eagles players.
- Competition Players will have team training once per week plus a home and away competition game on either a Saturday or Sunday morning dependent on numbers. Competition games at MiniRoos level have no scores or ladders.
- All U8 players in our competition teams have an additional one-night technical training per week with qualified specialist coaches.

Parental Involvement

All U5 - U8 Mini Eagles teams have a volunteer parent coach who will be offered a refund of registration fees. If no volunteers, we will seek a non-parent coach to step in, however a coaching levy may apply to fund the coaching costs.

All U8 competition teams will need a parent volunteer team manager. Please contact the Operations Manager if you are interested in this role.

As a community club we rely heavily on volunteers at the club. There are many ways in which you can contribute so please let us know if you have any special skills or interests that can help enrich our club.
